CONTRACT APPROVAL

1. Motion Authorizing the Mayor to Enter into a Three-Year Service Agreement with Spectrum Enterprise for Fiber Internet 1 Gbps Internet Service Including Five Static IP Addresses in the Monthly Amount of \$900.00

Mayor explain the motion regarding various incidences (ex. Dudley), there is not enough manpower to have officers sitting in these areas all day. The cameras will be hooked up to dispatch and if something appears suspicious, they can alert units. The system needs updated and the city needed more speed and bandwidth. Direct Benedict further explained city hall and the phone system will remain on the updated line and all police, fire, cameras, will move over to the fiber network.

Councilwoman Antosh asked the number of cameras for Dudley. Mayor Vanni mentioned there is no number set but too many incidences and resident complaints, so this will be the most

efficient way to police these areas.

Councilwoman Bisbee asked if this will work with the cameras at Manry. Mayor replied no and Director Kless did not feel the park needed to be paired with dispatch, but it can be revisited. Councilwoman Bisbee will discuss with Director Kless, as there was an incident over the weekend. President Koudela asked if there will be enough bandwidth to include Manry and Director Benedict answered the contractor mentioned there was more than enough. Roosevelt is not included since it is and open field only used for soccer where the other parks have structures for vandalism.
