

Hi Everyone,

Happy New Year! I hope 2025 will be better year for everyone.

City Council decided to change the start time for council meetings from 7:30pm to 6:30pm starting in 2025. Council will vote on 12/17/24 to Amended Chapter 121, Section 121.01 of the Codified Ordinance titled Meetings. The meeting days will stay the same on the first and third Tuesday of each month unless voted that a meeting be canceled.

Ordinance 311.07 Deposit of snow on streets prohibited.

No person removing snow from any driveway or sidewalk within the City shall deposit the same on the pavement or sidewalk of any public streets or in any tree lawn in any public street except the tree lawn immediately in front of the premises from which the snow is removed.

Please do not throw snow into the street or block sidewalks with piles of snow. If you're shoveling the snow throw it on to your tree lawn or front yard, not the sidewalk. Direct the snow to your yard, not the street if snow blowing. Snowplow drivers need to push the piles of snow onto the resident's front lawn and not the sidewalk. Creating a large pile of snow makes it in possible to walk on the sidewalk and forcing people to walk in the street which is unsafe. Please considerate the safety of our mail carriers and fellow residents who continue to walk and run during the winter months.
