### June 9<sup>th</sup> to August 8<sup>th</sup>

Willowick Summer Day Camp is a nine-week theme-based program available to children ages 5 to 12 years old. Your child must turn 5 old by June 1<sup>st</sup> in order to participate. Summer camp is divided into the following age groups; 5 & 6 year olds, 7 & 8 year olds, and 9 to 12 year olds. Camp fee includes a Camp/Swim pass (good for admission to both pools this summer), a camp t-shirt, off field trips and all crafts and supplies. Camp is held Monday through Friday from 7:30am to 4:30pm (No camp Friday, July 4<sup>th</sup>). Your child will need to bring a packed lunch daily to camp along with their swimsuit, towel, tennis shoes and socks.
